

Potential Regulation Analysis Commercial Cannabis License Capacity

Date: 12/4/17

Per Community Plan Area

Retail ratio - Maximum 1:10,000 licenses per community plan resident

Cultivation ratio - 1 sq ft of cultivated area for every 350 sq ft of land zoned MR1, M1, MR2, M2, and M3
(Max 100,000 sq ft and max 15 licenses at ratio of 1 license per 2,500 sq ft of allowable cultivated area)

Microbusiness ratio - Maximum 1:7,500 licenses per community plan resident

Manufacturing ratio - Maximum 1:7,500 licenses per community plan resident

Note: Each microbusiness license with on-site retail sales counts against retail limit.

Each square foot of cultivation at a licensed microbusiness counts against cultivation limit.
